

## Recommended integration of FlipBooks into a website

A FlipBook consists mainly out of following components, that are all situated in a directory, e.g. a WEB:

File	Web/abc.opf or Web/abc.xml	- FlipBook Control file
directory	Web/abc_opf_files	- directory with all data concerning FlipBook
directory	Web/languages	- directory with languages files
file	Web/flipviewerexpress.html	- file that calls up FlipBook
file	Web/main.swf	- FVX application

All files and directories need to be uploaded into a directory on the webserver.

### **Please note:**

If you're using a FTP program, you need to mind that you have chosen "binary" for in transfer mode.

If the file does not show clear text (it shows e.g. Chinese characters), you didn't choose "binary" in transfer mode.

To proof if all files are uploaded correct, you could call up e.g. the file ENG.xml.

If the FlipBook is situated on [www.webserver.de/Web/abc.xml](http://www.webserver.de/Web/abc.xml), you will find the file ENG.xml on [www.webserver.de/Web/languages/ENG.xml](http://www.webserver.de/Web/languages/ENG.xml)

### **Integration of flipviewerexpress.html file into the website**

To reach the highest display area without browser navigation, the FlipBook should be integrated via window.open. Example:

```
<a href="javascript:;" onClick='window.open("flipviewerexpress.html" , "",  
"width="+window.screen.availWidth+", height="+window.screen.availHeight+", left=0, top=0, location=no,  
menubar=no, resizable=no, scrollbars=no, status=no, toolbar=no)'\>
```

## Flash Version

In case of any problems with the flash version, you could choose the minimal version in the file flipviewerxpress.html. That works with parameter:

```
// Major version of Flash required  
var requiredMajorVersion = 9;  
// Minor version of Flash required  
var requiredMinorVersion = 0;  
// Minor version of Flash required  
var requiredRevision = 45;
```

Version 9.0.45 is the recommended minimal version.

## Language

The standard language for startup of the FlipBook you could change in the file flipviewerxpress.html with parameter:

```
openParms.language = "ENG";
```

ENG = German, ENG = English, FRA = French, ITA = Italian

The language parameter could also be insert into the URL:

```
www.webserver.de/Web/flipviewerxpress.html?lang=ENG
```

## Link to a specific page

With following parameter you could open directly a specific page (in this case page 10).

```
www.webserver.de/Web/flipviewerxpress.html?pn=10
```
